## THE 2023 SEFA MARKET SURVEY

The survey was completed yesterday and the results are astounding. Remember that the last market survey was completed just before the COVID pandemic shut down much of the world and abruptly ended the lives of so many. In January 2020 we reported that by 2024 the global revenue generated from laboratory furniture, enclosures and related equipment was estimated to reach (USD) \$2.3 billion. The 2024 estimate has now skyrocketed to \$3 billion. In 2020, the global compounded growth rate for our industry was estimated to be 4.3%. The current estimated global CAGR for the next five years is now 6.8%. (In the U.S. alone, the CAGR has increased to a staggering 8.6% for the next five years vs. previous estimates of 3.8%.)
